もう一段上の英語俳句を目指そう

第13回山寺芭蕉記念館英語俳句大会 実行委員長 大場 登

初めに、「山寺から世界に」と意気込む本大会開催の趣旨にご理解をいただき、支えていた だきました(公財)山形市文化振興事業団並びに山形市関係機関に感謝申し上げます。海外36 ヵ国を含む方々からご応募いただき、立派な入選作品集を完成することができました。

さて、今回8月末日締め切りの応募者数を見てみますと、第1~3部の参加者数合計は、前 回を約2.6倍上回る2364人で、ほっとすると同時にこれは審査等の作業が大変だとの思いが 先立ちました。増加理由の一つは、募集期間を、従前より約2ヵ月遅れの7月1日~8月31日 に設定したことに依ることと思われます。これにより、中高が、何かと慌ただしい新学期をで はなく、夏休み等を利用し作句に余裕をもって取り組むことができたからだと思われます。特 に、中学生の参加者数が、前回を約4倍上回る1085人の参加があったことに仰天。これは、 前述の理由のほかに、募集要項等が中学校に浸透し、英語俳句指導に興味を持って取り組んで くださる先生方が増加したことにもよるのかなと推測しています。また、コロナ禍に関わらず、 日本人大人の部も、2.3 倍増えたことも驚きでした。ただ、中高生の部で感じた問題点は、参 加者数は増えたけれども、完成度が今一である作品が目立ちました。願わくは、学校現場で、 もう少し、生徒に英語俳句への理解度を深めていただいたり、推敲などを綿密に行っていただ いたりすることなどにより、改善・向上の余地大いにあり、と思いました。第1~第3部まで の入選者数を見ますと、前回は399人、今回は423人とほぼ変わらない総計となりました。審 査は第1次、2次と2回行いましたが、1次審査の入選句を選定する段階で気づいたことは、 応募者総数は増えても作品の質的向上は余り見られなかったことです。私たちの願いは、今後 も応募を目指す皆さんが、英語俳句の学びを更に深められ、果敢にチャレンジしてほしいこと です。以下、第2次審査会で審査員から出された講評の抜粋を参考のために掲載します。

「俳句は簡潔な表現をめざす世界最短の文学。英語俳句もまた、必要最小限に短く表現する ことに意義があり。俳句の17音は英語俳句では音節数に当たると考えられるが、厳密な規定 はない。5・7・5を音節数とすると、情報量は英語の方が圧倒的に多く盛り込め、英語俳句 は5・7・5以内の音節数に収めた方が簡潔な作品になる。たとえば、芭蕉の「古池や…」を James Kirkup(英国詩人)は pond frog plop!と3音節で表現、簡潔の極みに達しています」。

「中高生が、英語俳句に立ち向かっている姿に感心させられたが、願わくは、俳句の精神の基本をつかんでほしい。例えば、俳句では自己主張を余りしない特徴がある。世の課題やそれを解決する市民の責務を表現した投句もありましたが、意見をしっかり主張することは好ましいことですが、俳句では違います。これは、俳句が禅の性質と同質的だと言われる所以。また、俳句では説明的になることも歓迎されない。主述関係を表す"clause"は避け語句を併置し、読者にイメージを喚起させることが肝要である」。

以上を参考にされ、もう一段上の俳句作りを目指されますよう願っております。

Aiming Even Higher in the Pursuit of the English Haiku

The Yamadera Basho Memorial Museum English Haiku Contest is one which seeks to spread the English haiku from Yamadera to the rest of the world, and we would first like to thank the Yamagata City Culture Foundation and the city of Yamagata for their support of this contest and its purpose. This year we received haiku submissions from applicants throughout Japan as well as 36 countries around the world, and we are pleased to present these results in this collection of selected haiku submissions.

Submissions for this year's contest were accepted until the end of August, whereupon we found ourselves with submissions from a total of 2364 applicants from the four divisions, 2.6 times the number of participants in last year's contest. While this increase in applicants necessitated a longer screening period, this was a development we gladly welcomed. One of the reasons for this increase can be attributed to the timing of the submission period, which took place from July 1 to August 31, approximately two months later than our past submission period. By accepting submissions after the traditionally busy start of the Japanese school year, it appears that junior high and high school students were able to spend more time, perhaps including their summer holiday, composing their haiku submissions. We were particularly surprised to receive submissions from 1085 junior high school students, an increase of over four times from last year, and this also seems to be thanks to an increasing awareness of our contest among junior high school teachers, who took an interest in our contest and gave their students the opportunity to try their hand at English haiku composition. The coronavirus pandemic was also unable to dampen the enthusiasm of Division 1 Japanese general public applicants, as exhibited by the more than twofold increase in participants from the previous year.

This significant increase in submissions, however, was not without its issues. While we were pleased at the increased participation of junior high school students, many of their submissions would have benefited from more careful instruction from their teachers regarding the English haiku and its composition, and we hope this is something we will be seeing in the future. In total, 423 applicants from the four contest divisions passed the first screening this year, a number very close to the 399 applicants selected the previous year. While we held two screenings to determine the selected haiku submissions and then select the prize-winning works, the first screening illustrated that while we received significantly more submissions this year, this did not lead to a corresponding increase in selected submissions. It is our hope that future participants will make an effort to deepen their understanding of the English haiku, and will apply themselves even more assiduously to the composition of these poems.

At the second screening, the judges made numerous observations regarding this year's body of submissions. One judge noted that the Japanese haiku may be considered the world's shortest and most concise form of literature, which naturally means that brevity is very important for the English haiku as well. While the 17-syllable structure of the Japanese haiku is also generally applied to English haiku, it is not considered an absolute rule. 5-7-5 syllable English haiku poems may contain significantly more information than Japanese haiku of the same syllable structure, and some English haiku may be shortened even further. *Pond/frog/plop!* – the English poet James Kirkup's three-syllable interpretation of Matsuo Basho's famous "*furuike ya*" haiku – serves as an example of how succinct an English haiku may be.

Another judge also noted that while it is heartening to see junior high school students take on the challenge of English haiku composition, such students could greatly benefit from learning the fundamental tenets of the haiku poem. For example, some students inserted personal opinions or positions into their poems, such as their ideas regarding the state of the world and the responsibilities of its citizens. While it is admirable for students to develop such beliefs and opinions, these are generally not directly stated in haiku poems, which are considered to have a Zen Buddhist quality and shy away from being explanatory. Rather than using clauses that simply state subject-predicate relationships, it is better to seek out words and phrases that evoke images in the mind of the reader. We hope that contest participants will find these observations of some value, and will make use of them to aim even higher in their pursuit of the English haiku.
