はしがき

平和希求が高まる中で

第15回山寺芭蕉記念館英語俳句大会 実行委員長 大場 登

節目の第15回山寺芭蕉記念館英語俳句大会の入選句集をここにお届けできますことをうれし く思います。ご支援いただきました関係各位に感謝いたします。

さて、本大会の応募者総数がこれまでで最多になりました。その理由の一つは、昨今海外でも 俳句愛好者がどんどん増える中、第1部を「日本人大人」と、「外国人大人」とに分けて募集す るユニークな方式への理解が深まったこと。そのことは、第1部大人の部には国内19都府県、 海外31カ国から応募があったことにも表れていると思います。応募状況に関してもう一つの特 徴は、第2部高校生の部の応募者数が減少(前回719人・今回507人)、第3部中学生の部が増 えたことです。(前回1107人・今回1612人)(本入選作品集4頁ご参照)我が国の中高外国語教 育の学習指導要領上での英語俳句の取り扱い方や、中高における夏休みの長短の違いなどが原因 と思われますが、更に分析が必要だと思います。

第15回大会の作品の募集期間は2023年7月1日から8月25日の2ヵ月弱。応募者総数は過 去最多の2358人3089句となり、2次にわたる審査を通過した387人の449句を本入選句集に掲 載いたしました。

入選句の中にも見られますが、やはり英語の俳句も自然や日常生活などを主題として詠んだも のが例年同様多いのですが、今回数的に目立ったのは、ウクライナ戦争やその他の紛争などが即 時終結し平和を希求するメッセージを感じさせる作品でした。世界中の人たちと思いや願いを共 有することも英語俳句に取り組む大きな動機の一つだと思いました。

9月28日に行われた第2次審査には、飯島武久山形大学名誉教授(審査員長)、万里小路譲山 形県詩人協会副会長、翻訳家リサ・ソマーズさん、相馬周一郎(公財)山形市文化振興事業団理 事長、並びに大場登実行委員長が当たりました。審査中、審査員の方々から繰り返された英語俳 句作成上への助言は、「自然描写や心情描写、それに世界観など、通常のセンテンス生成に縛ら れることなく、簡潔に大胆に表現してほしい」と言うことでした。

終わりに、英語俳句愛好者に於かれましては更なる研鑽を積まれ、次回大会にも是非応募して くださるようお願いいたします。 Foreword:

Haiku Composition Amidst a Growing Desire for Peace

We are pleased to present the results of the 15th Yamadera Basho Memorial Museum English Haiku Contest in this collection of selected haiku submissions, and we would like to express our deep gratitude to all those who continue to support this contest.

This year, we received a record number of submissions from the greatest number of applicants to have so far taken part in our contest, something which I believe is attributable to several factors. One is the growing number of haiku enthusiasts overseas, along with the positive response to our contest's unique Division 1 format, which creates separate divisions for Japanese and overseas applicants, and I believe this is underscored by the fact that Japanese adults from 19 prefectures and overseas applicants from 31 countries chose to take part in this year's contest. In addition, although we saw a decreased number of Division 2 high school participants (507 applicants this year, down from 719 applicants the year before), we witnessed the opposite trend among Division 3 junior high school participants, with 1612 applicants this year, a significant increase from the 1107 applicants who took part in last year's contest. (Please refer to p. 4 for more details on participant and submission numbers.) These fluctuations may result from the way in which haiku poems are utilized within the English language learning curriculum at junior high and high school, as well as differences in the length of school terms and summer holidays at the junior high and high school levels, and we will continue to give consideration to factors such as these.

During the approximately two-month application period, which lasted from July 1 to August 25, we received 3089 submissions from 2358 applicants in Japan and abroad. Of these, 449 submissions from 387 applicants passed the first screening and appear in this haiku collection.

While the majority of the English haiku poems we receive continue to be composed around timeless themes such as nature and daily life, this year we also noticed a significant number of poems which addressed the war in Ukraine and other conflicts, calling for an end to hostilities and a return to peace. Haiku poems allow us to share thoughts and feelings like these with other people around the world, something which I believe many people find an important motivation in their haiku composition.

The second screening to select the Grand Prize and two Distinguished Work recipients in each category was carried out on September 28, 2023 by a five-member judging panel consisting of Takehisa lijima (Professor Emeritus of Yamagata University), Joe Maricoji (Vice-President of the Yamagata Prefecture Poetry Association), Lisa Somers (translator), Shuichiro Soma (Yamagata City Cultural Promotion Foundation Chairman), and myself. During this screening, the individual judges repeatedly spoke of their appreciation for works which broke free from the confines of ordinary sentence structure and used succinct and dynamic language to depict natural scenes, emotions and worldviews.

In closing, I would like to express my hope that haiku enthusiasts around the world will continue to polish and develop their haiku composing skills, and will share the fruits of these efforts with us at next year's contest.
