Jionji Temple

This ancient temple is believed to have been established during the Nara period by the decree of Emperor Shomu. Within the temple grounds, the main hall, which is an Important Cultural Property, a three story pagoda and Yakushido Hall stand together majestically marking the passage of time. The Buddhist statues from the Heian and Kamakura periods are designated as Important Cultural Properties as they are the greatest treasures of Buddhist art in Japan. The former temple precincts once covered the hillside and now have been designated a National Historic Site.

Cast-iron Buddhist Bowl


A rice washing bowl delivered by a Yachi caster in 1606 (Keicho 11). It is said that putting one's head in this bowl prevents dementia and makes one feel and look younger.



Designated a Sagae City Natural Monument

Chigo-zakura

It is characterized by having 250 to 300 petals that bloom in two tiers. It is a famous cherry tree with three qualities: pureness, loveliness, and elegance.



Ceiling Painting

On the ceiling of the outer part of the main hall are paintings of dragons and celestial maidens. There are also many ema votive paintings, including one by Sadashige Gome. Please look up and enjoy this historic art.



Nationally designated Intangible Folk Cultural Property

Hayashike Bugaku

Every year on May 5, monks gather to read the Buddhist scriptures and perform eight pieces including Tsubame, Sante, Taiheiraku, Ninomai, and Ryoo. Many of the pieces are performed by the Hayashike.

The Jionji Terrace, conceived with the aim of enlightening the community and its future, embodies the concept of "connecting time and place" offering diverse programs that delve into the rich historical significance of the Jionji Temple grounds.

This rice planting dance is a tradition at Hiwada Hachiman Shrine. It is held on the second Saturday of September every year to pray for a good harvest.

Sagae Autumn Traditions / Sagae Festival Sep.

The Sagae Festival is held in conjunction with the festival at Hachimangu Shrine. Both have a long history and tradition. The Sagae Hachimangu Shrine Yabusame, horseback archery event, has been designated as a Prefectural Intangible Folk Cultural property. It is a heroic event that carries on the traditions of the Kamakura warriors. On the final day, the Mikoshi Festival is held. During the festival portable shrines are carried through town. It is one of the largest portable shrine festivals in Tohoku.






